Abstract

Abstract should briefly (up to 300 words) present a research, best practice stories or other similar theoretical or practical examples related to the topic and themes of the conference. It should contain important aspects of the paper such as hypothesis, purpose, methodology, results and conclusions.

If an author wishes to write a *full text paper*, they should elaborate on the causes that led to a certain research, clearly state problems and challenges that the paper aims to resolve, explain methodology and procedures used in a research. The abstract should end with most important findings, conclusions and possible consequences.

Best practice presentations and *poster presentations* abstract should present success stories in libraries and explain the grounds for introducing such activities and projects; moreover, the abstract should focus on monitoring, evaluation and importance of these activities.

Abstracts should not contain graphs, illustrations, literature, nor quotations longer than one or two sentences.
